## 1. Smoothing parameter when computing Postural Instability ( $CoP_{MAD}$ )

Trial-by-trial estimates of Postural Instability ( $CoP_{MAD}$ ) were smoothed using a Simple Moving Average (SMA), in which the value on each trial was mean-averaged with the values from the preceding N trials. For the data presented in the main manuscript, N was fixed at 2. However, as shown in **Fig S1**, other values yielded qualitatively similar results/conclusions.


