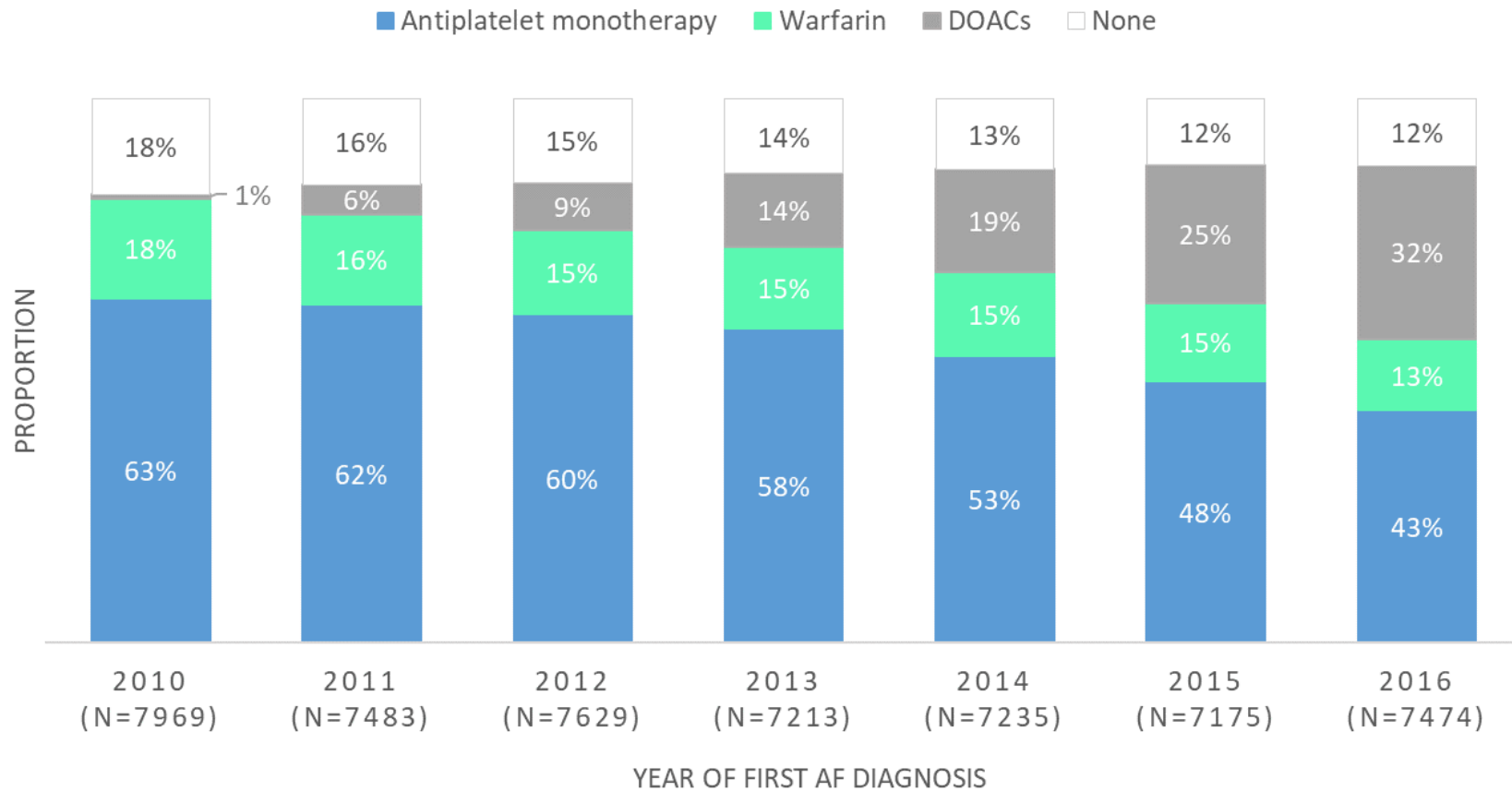


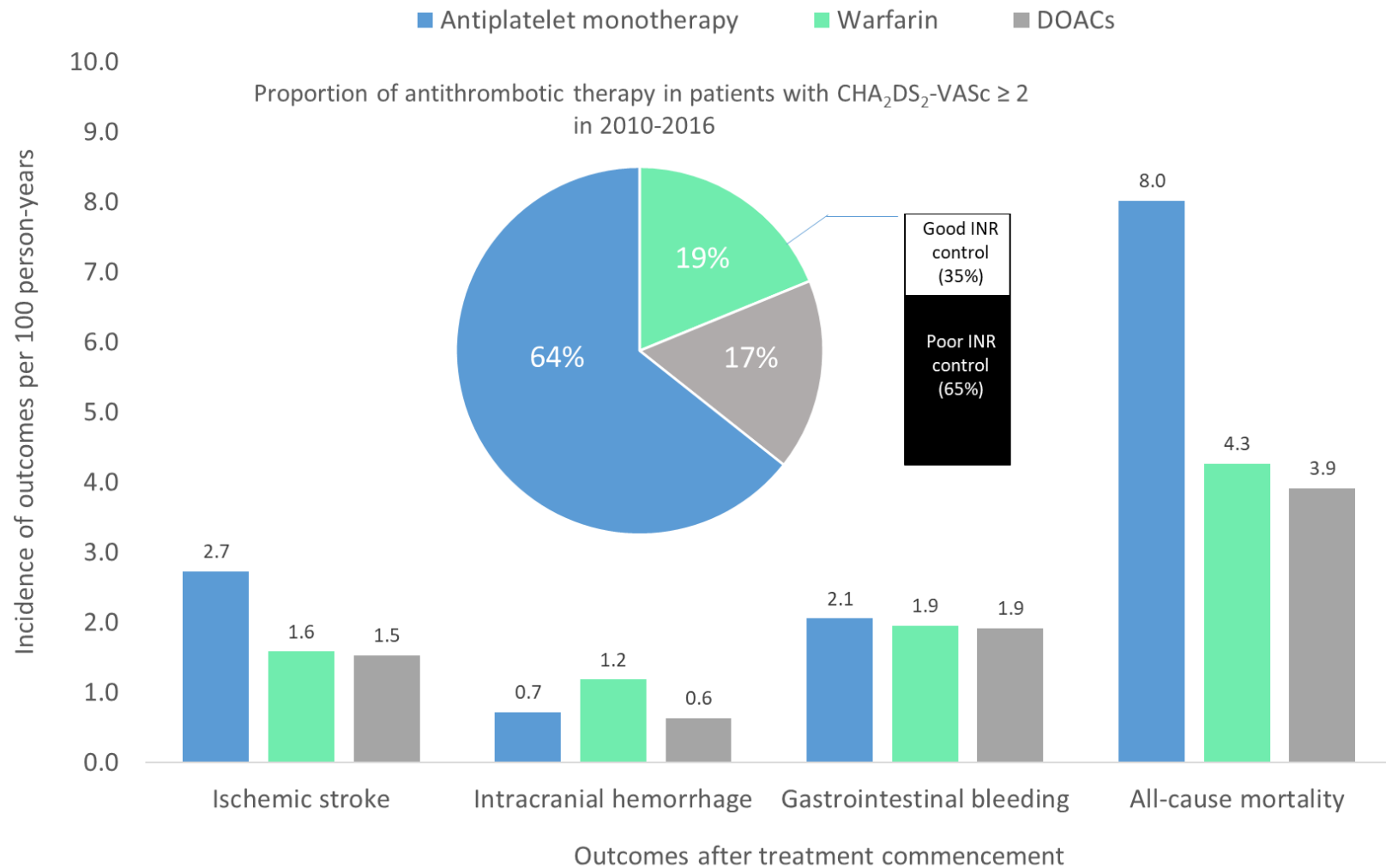
**Figure 1. Cohort selection**
