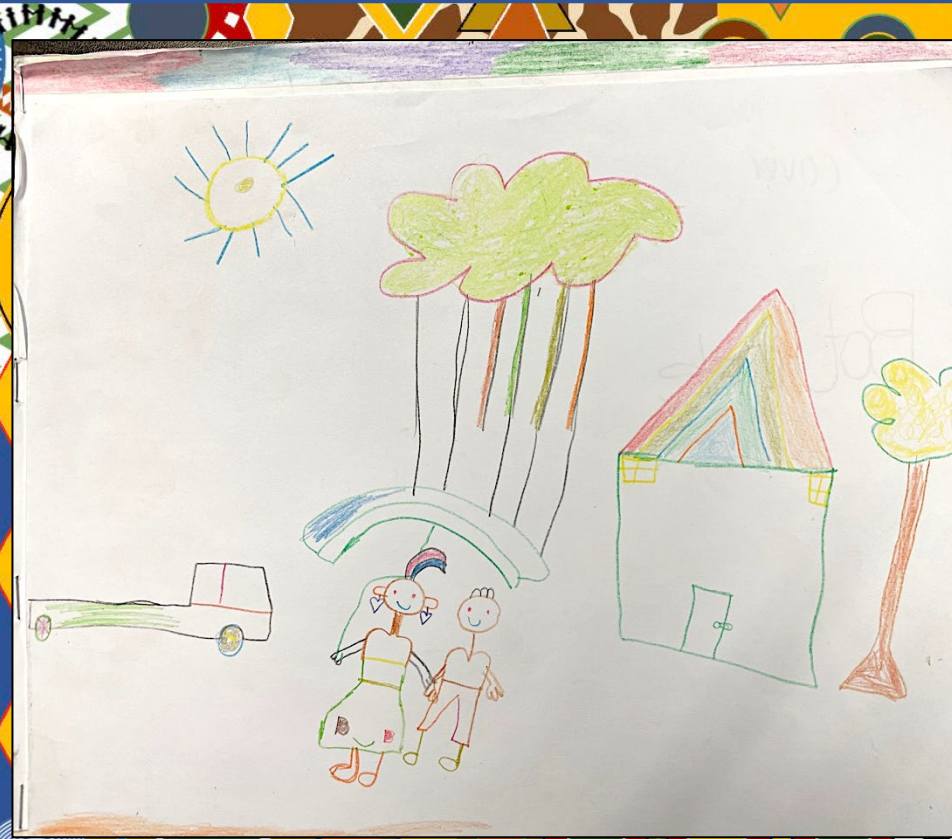

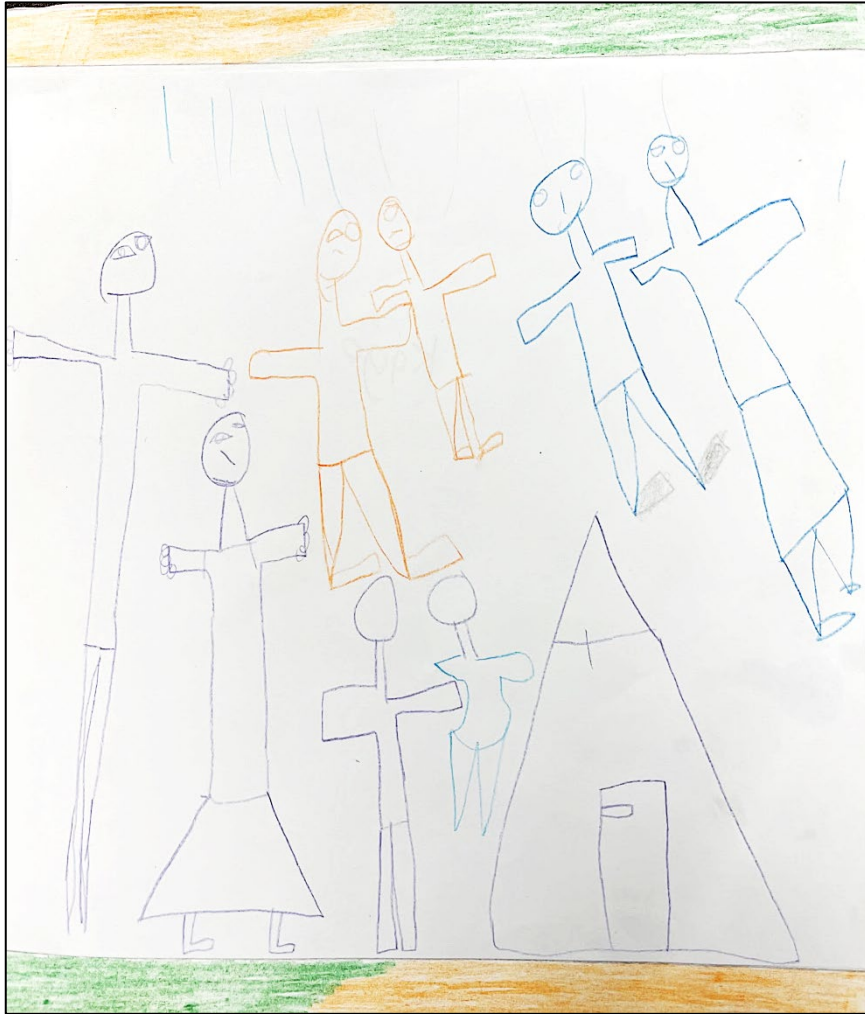
The man asked them to take him to the nearest store. He promised to give Thabiso and Neo money if they showed him a store.

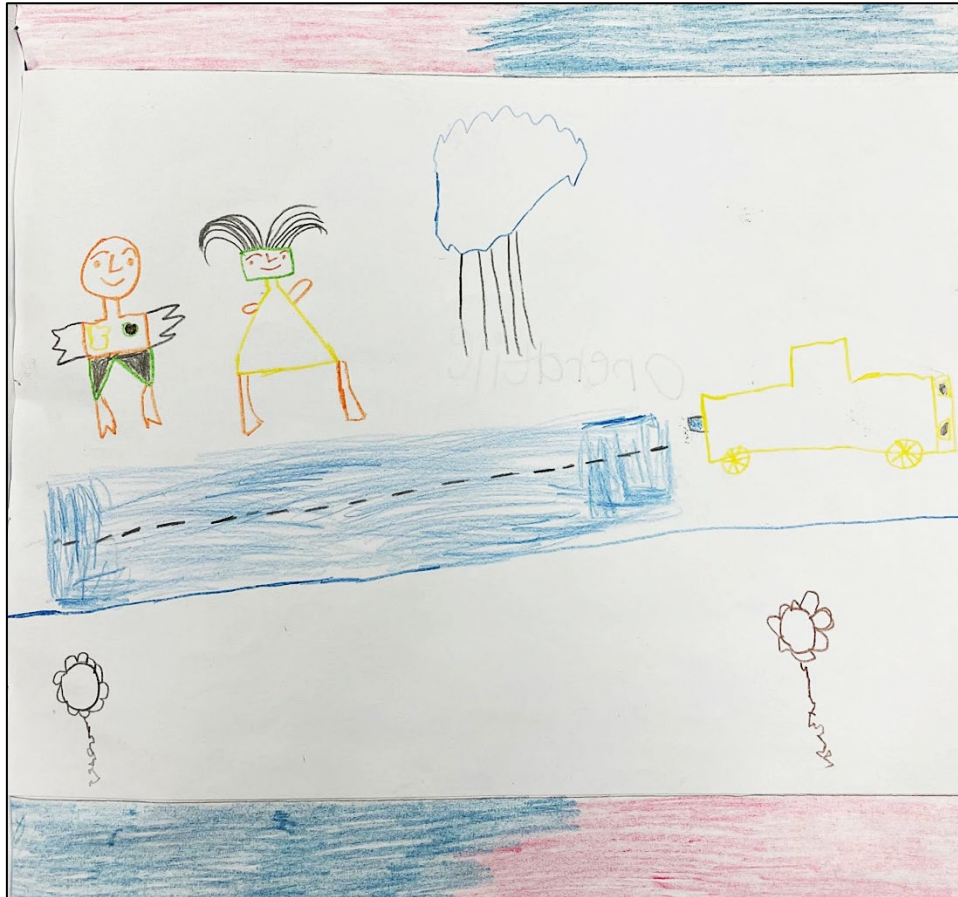
