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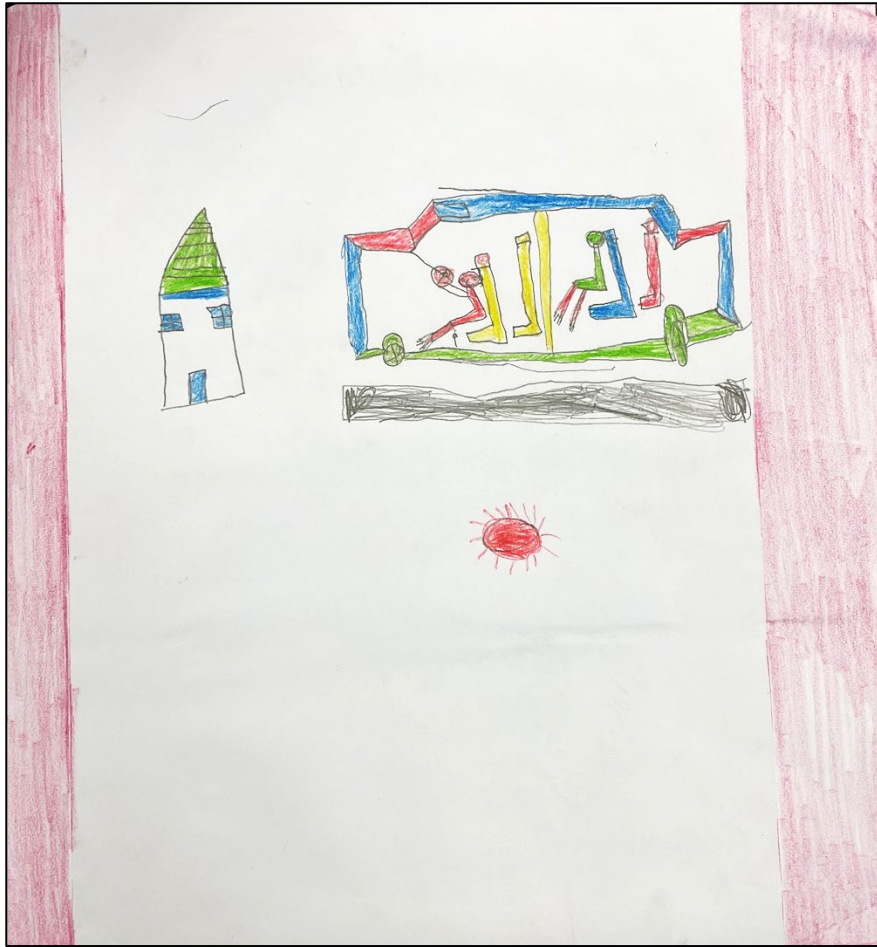
My father loves his car very much, even when it gives him problems. He does not want to sell it, because he loves it very much.

Your father will make sure that he fixes the car," said their father.



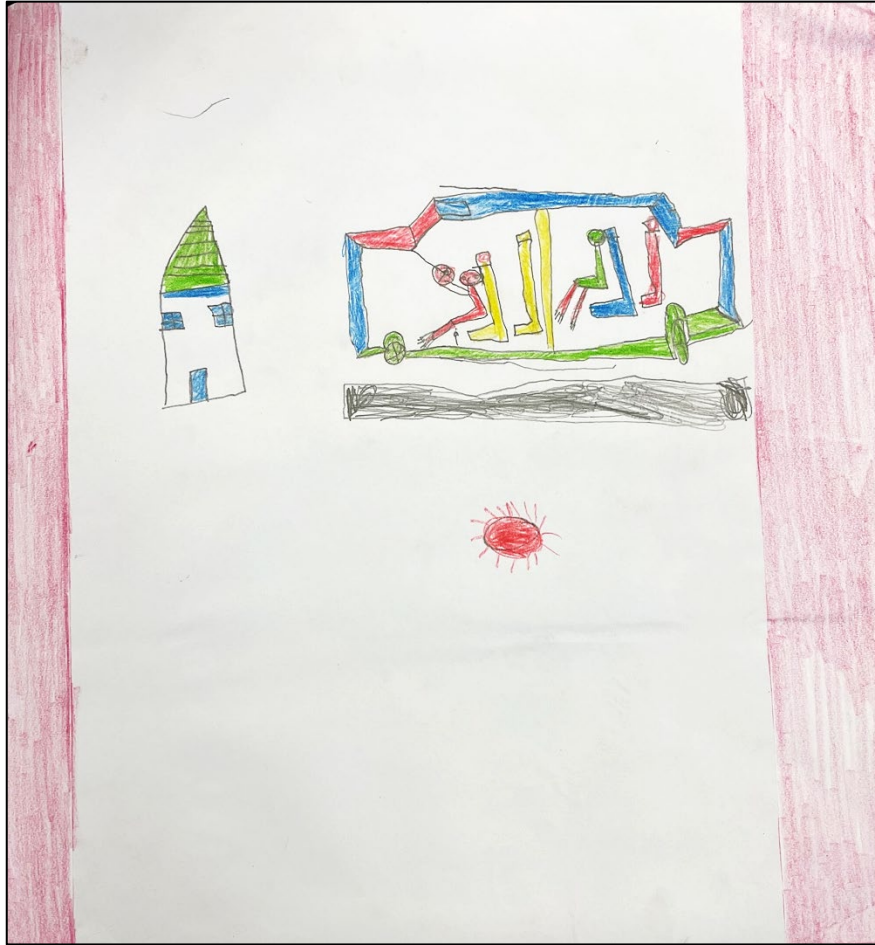


“As your father, I will make sure that I fix the car so I can take you to school. The school is too far for you to walk my children,” said their father.

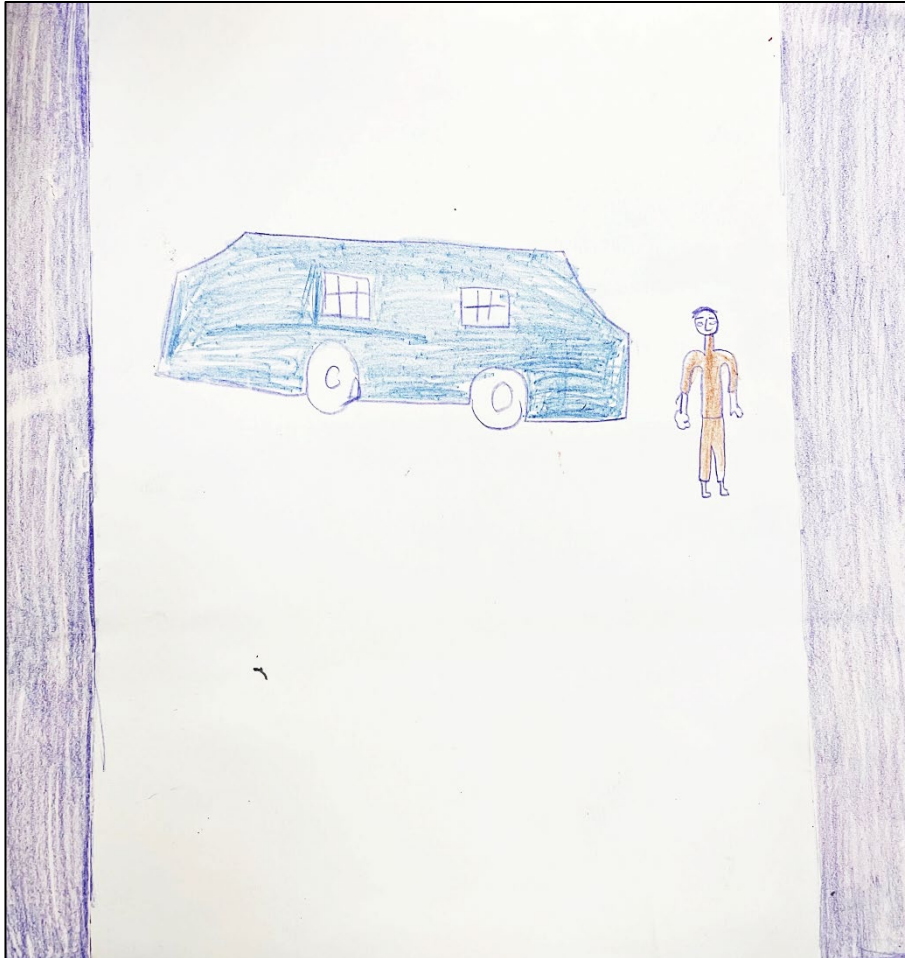


“I think the problem with this car is the oil, my children. I will pour some oil into the car to see why it is giving me problems.”
