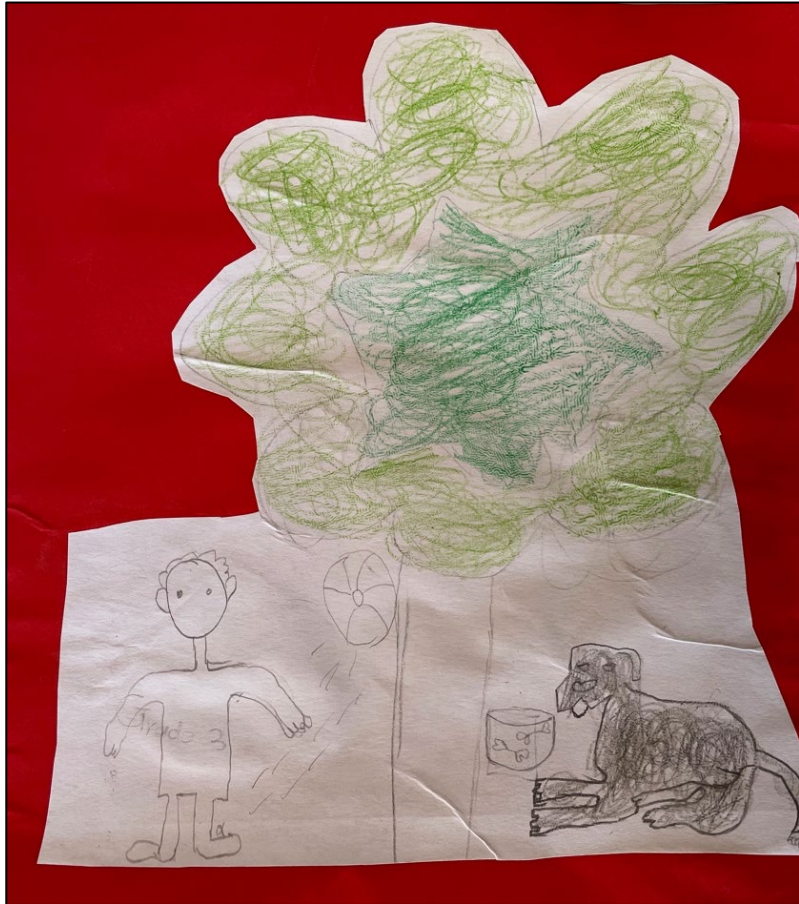
We were playing

not find it.



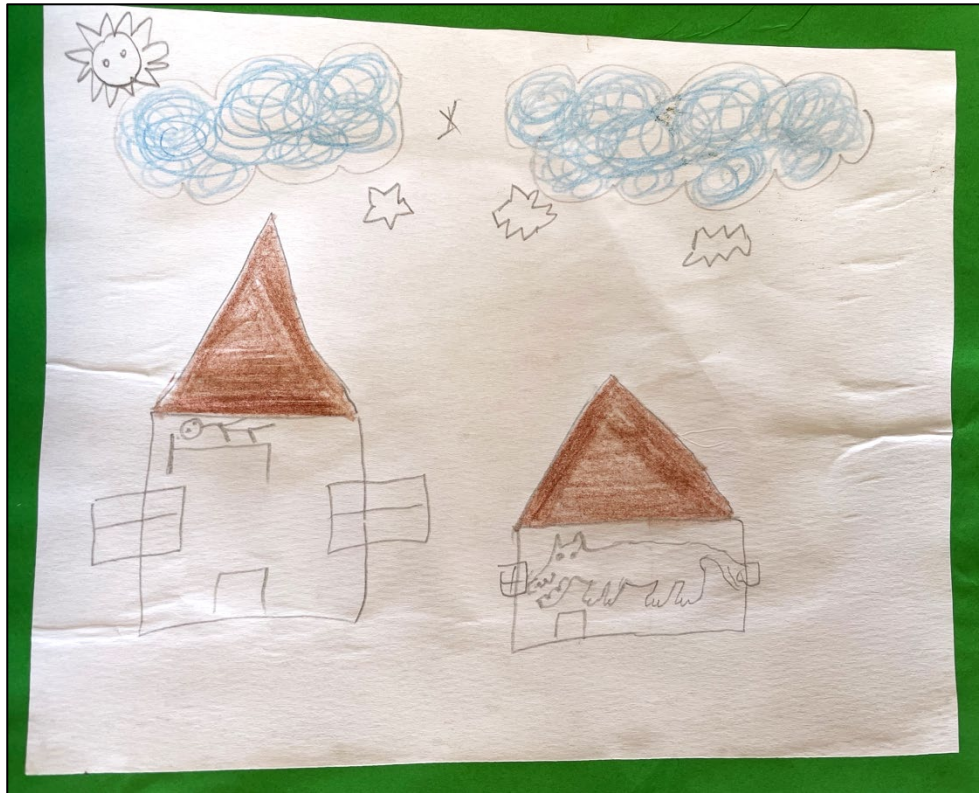
My friend Tumelo
