

Table 1: Top 10 research priorities in alcohol use disorder and alcohol-related liver disease

Ranking	Research question
1	What is the best way to engage people from minority ethnic groups or other under-represented groups in research about alcohol addiction?
2	What are the most effective ways to provide mental health/psychological support for those living experiencing alcohol use disorder?
3	Is it beneficial to have more education about alcohol awareness in schools, wider community settings and for all frontline healthcare workers?
4	What are the best ways of identifying alcohol-related liver disease, and how can early detection improve signposting to support and treatment services?
5	What are the best interventions for people with a combination of metabolic (e.g. obesity, diabetes) and alcohol risk factors for liver disease?
6	How do hormones, menopause, and ageing affect people living with alcohol-related difficulties? Do they impact recovery and what support do they need?
7	How effective are current care pathways for those experiencing alcohol use disorder, and how well are they understood, navigated, and accessed by those needing support?
8	What is the best way to support people with alcohol-related difficulties, and what information and awareness would be helpful to them?
9	What are the social, cultural, economic, and environmental factors contributing to drinking behaviour, alcohol use and addiction?
10	What stigma and distrust are there across alcohol support and treatment services, and how can we tackle this?
