can't.



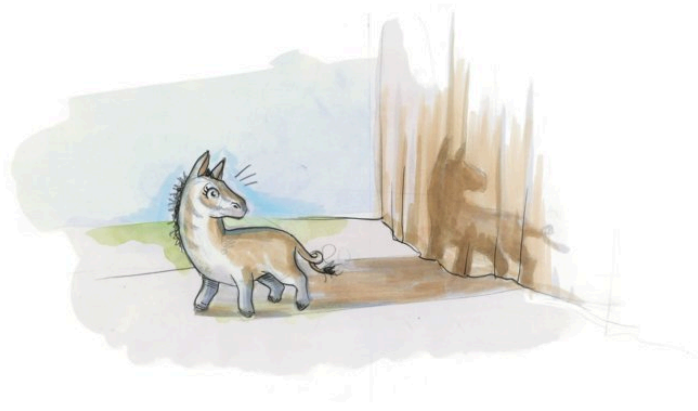
I've looked and
