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
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
Mmabatho is a beautiful town. It has a special library.




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This library has separate reading rooms. It has a room for children and another for parents.

this same library.




Kutlo is a boy who likes to read. His friend, Boitumelo, does not like to read and tears books.

One day, Kutlo told his friends about a story he had read.




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Boitumelo was interested in the story that Kutlo had told them. He realised that reading provides important knowledge.
