birthday every year.



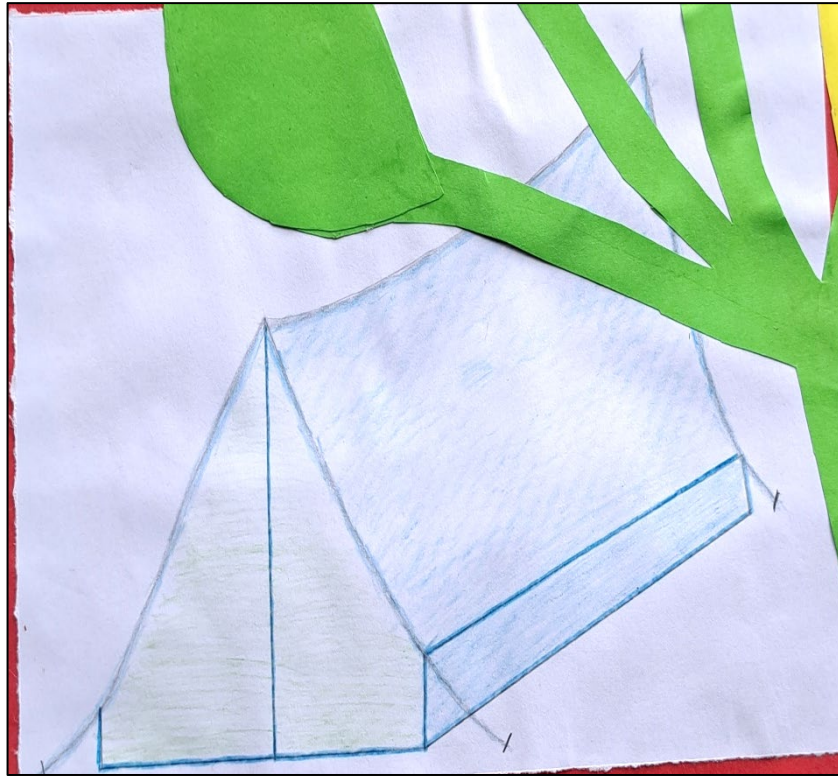
On the day of the celebration, the king slaughtered a cow for the community.

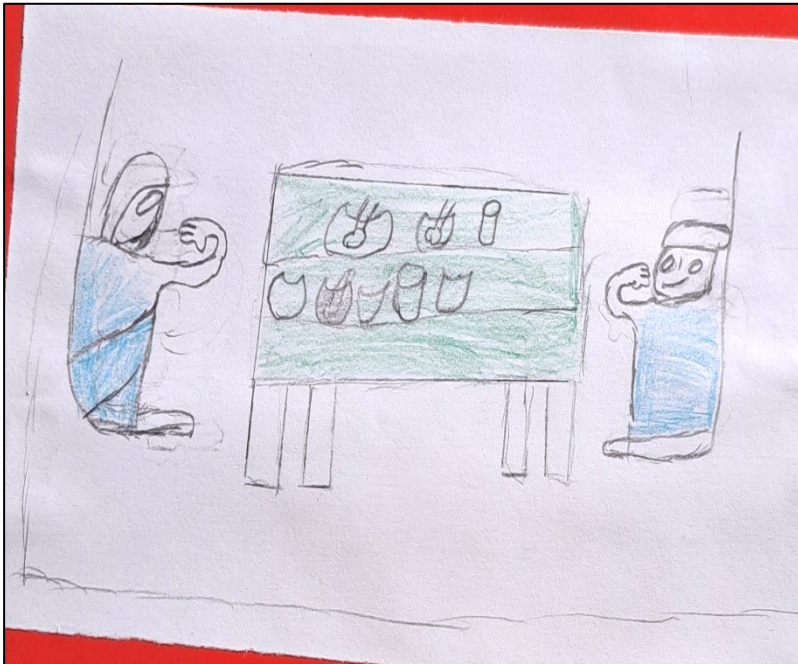
A big tent was decorated with beautiful colours, balloons and a big cake.
