This issue made the village community very sad.

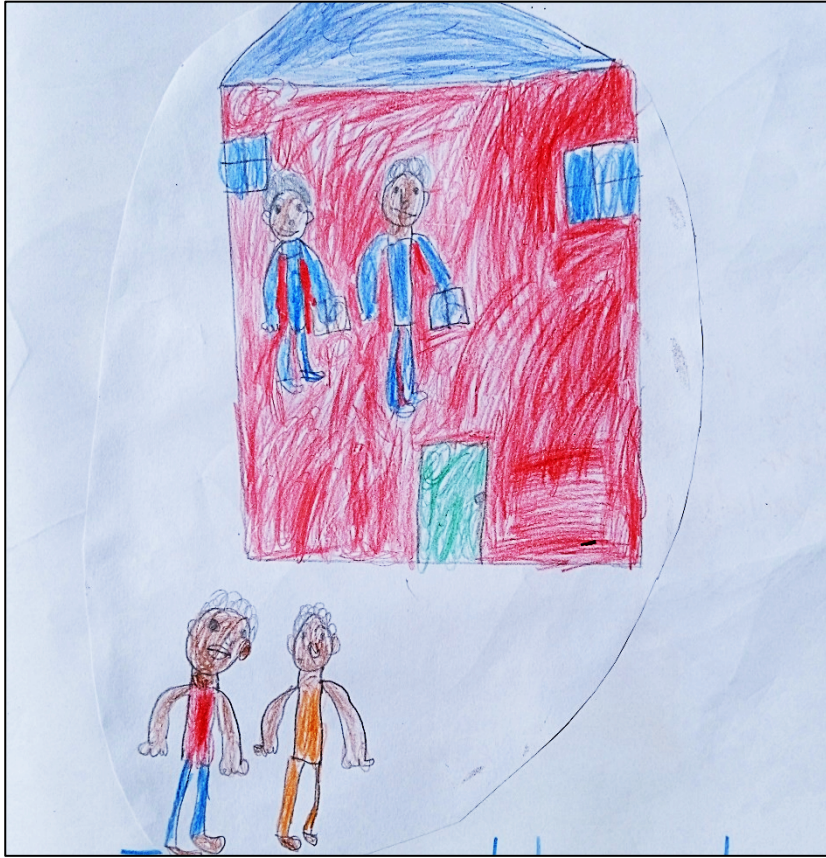


The community called a meeting where they discussed the solution to this problem.



The community agreed to build a children's home with the help of Chief Tau and councillor Nko.

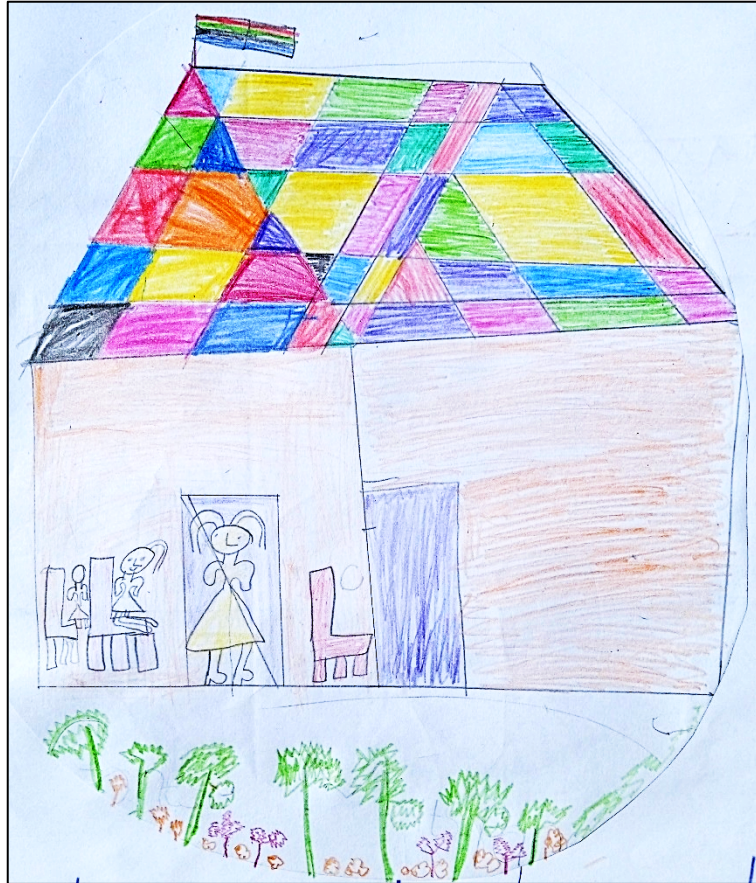




Chief Tau and councillor
