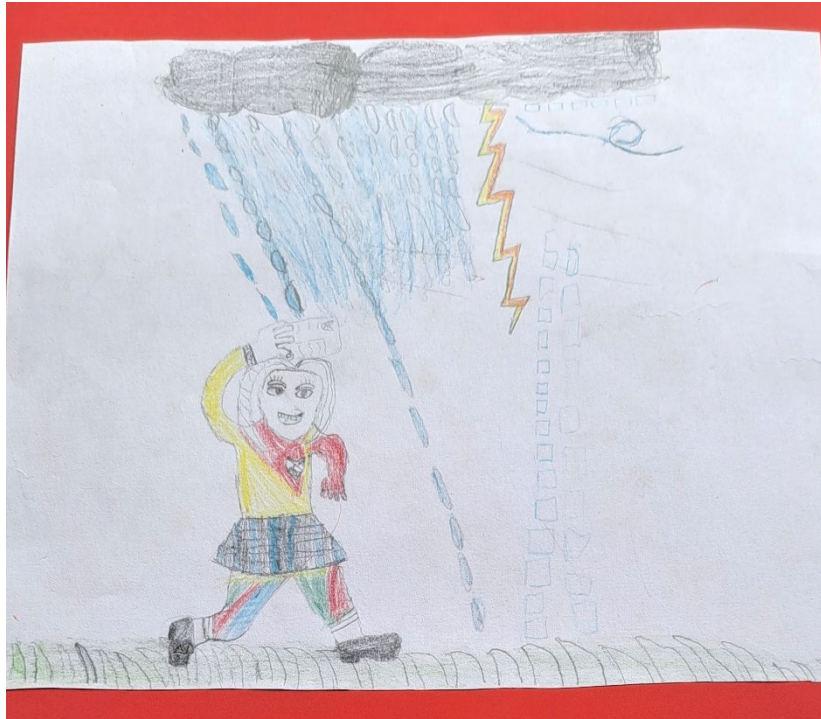

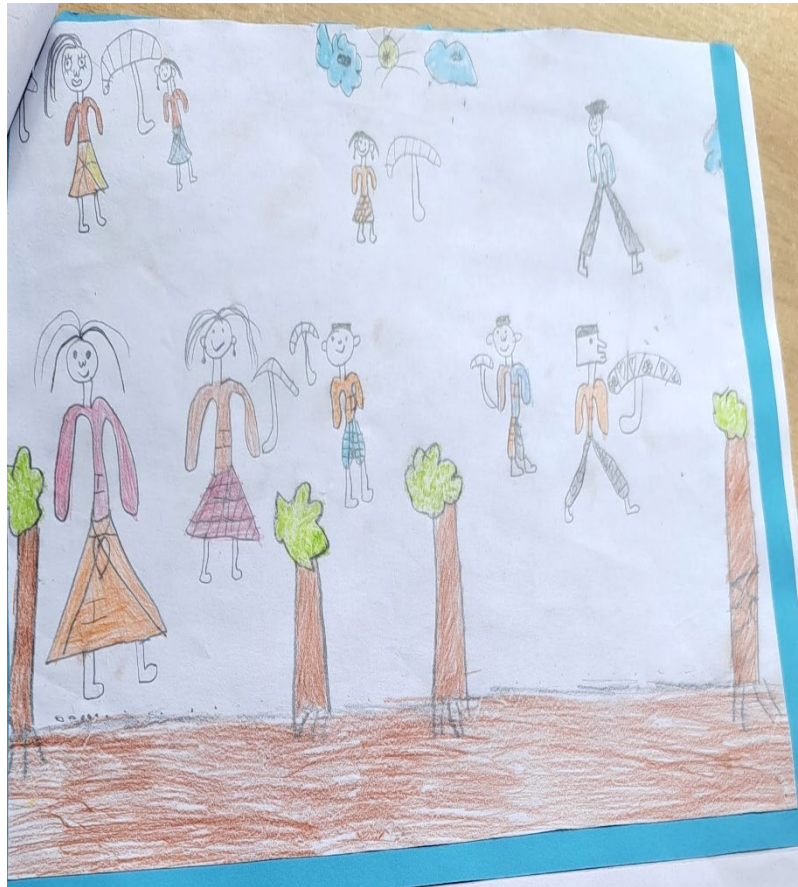
The winter of 2021
