Jacob's mother drinks alcohol every day. She does not cook. She does not have time for Jacob. She does not bothe him.



Jacob is often dirty. He cannot bear the pain of hunger. He eats from the dustbin. He does not attend school regularly.




Jacob started feeling ill. He ate rotten food. He had a stomach ache.


At the clinic, they gave him medicine. They returned home.
