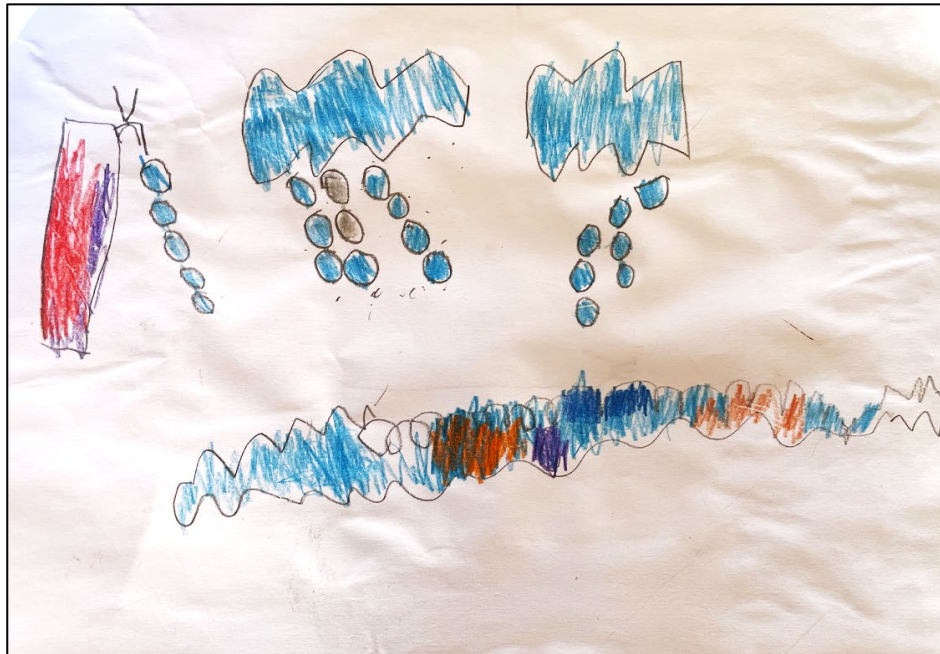

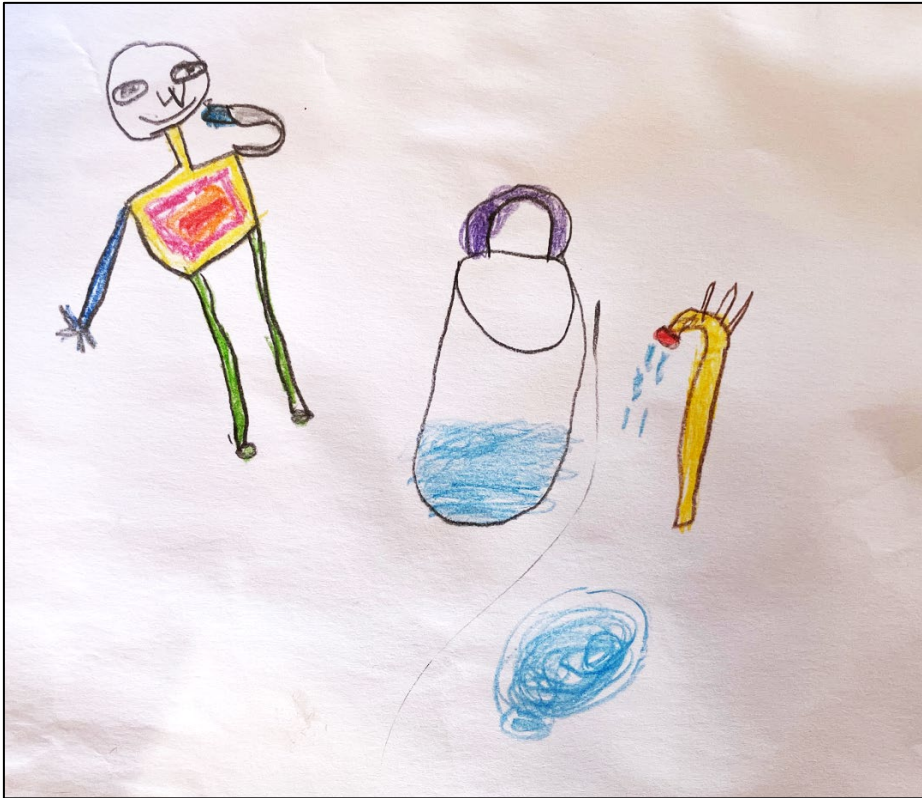

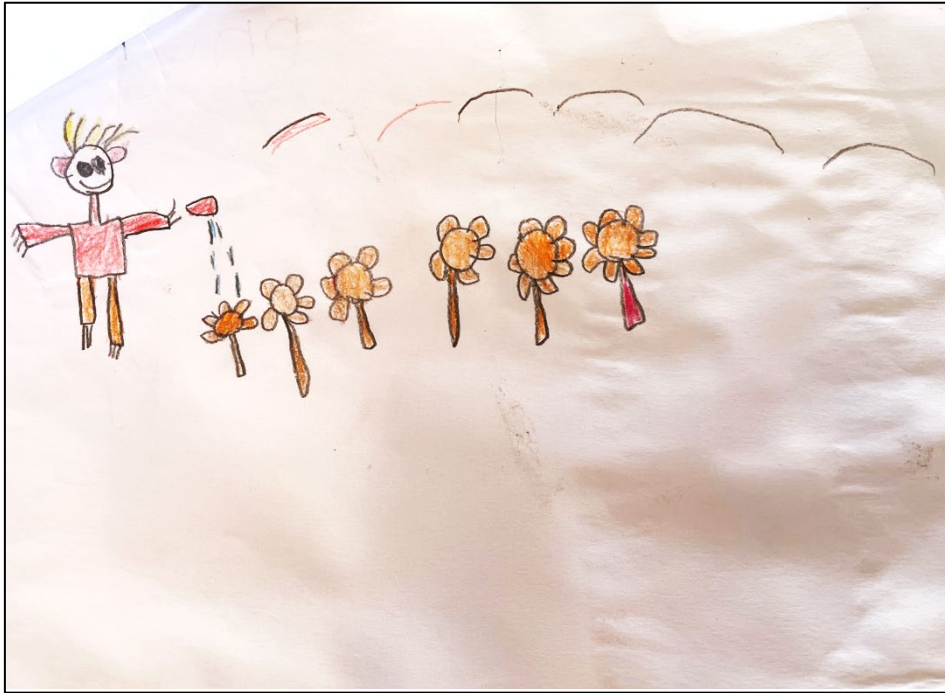

water, there is no life.



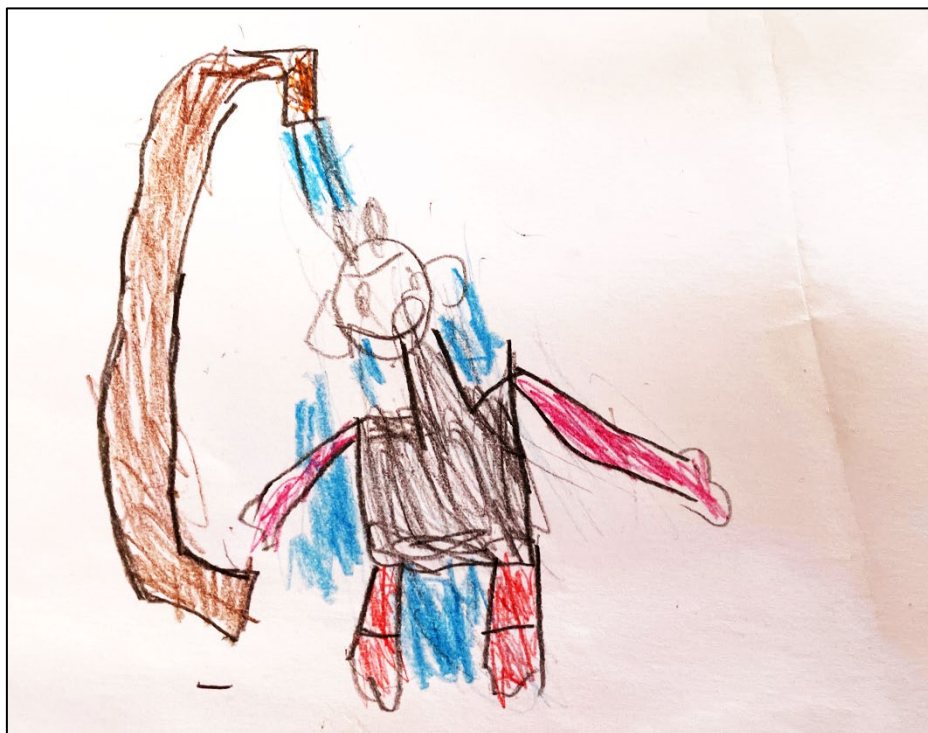
We drink water so that our bodies can be healthy and so that we can live.

with water.



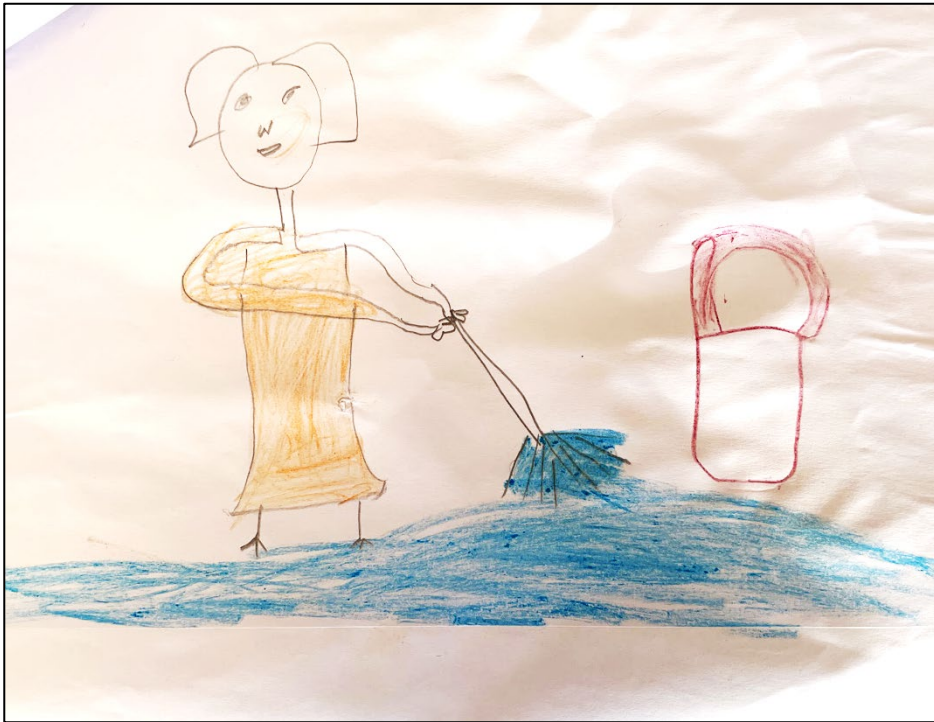
We wash our clothes
with water.



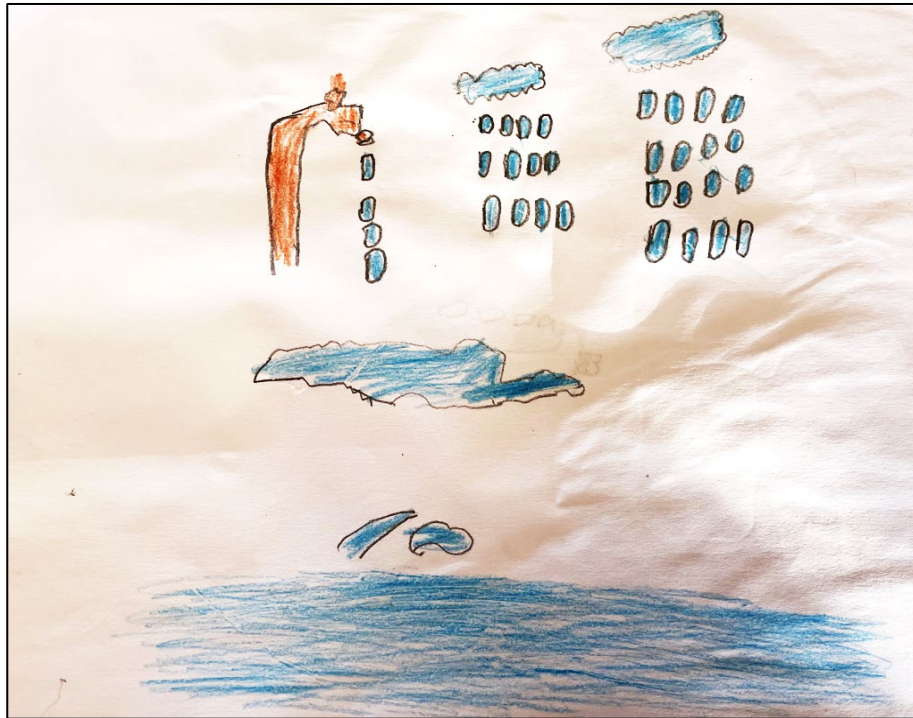
We wash our bodies with
