She's happy with her friends, talking about the next day's big game.



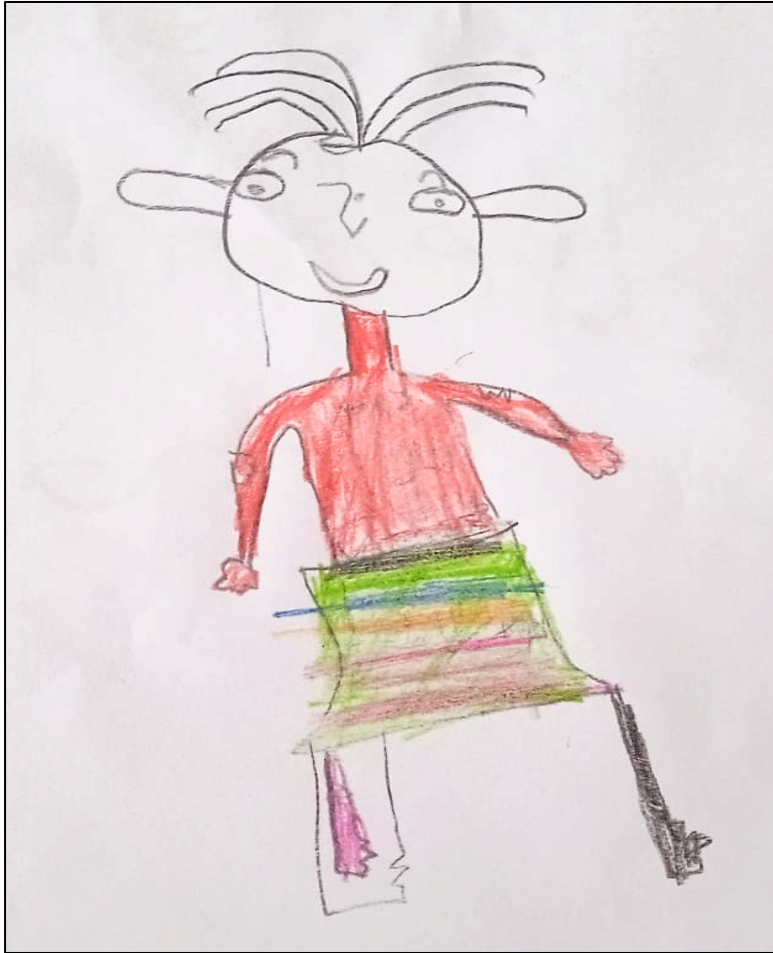
It's night. "How will I bathe? How will I eat? What about netball when I don't have hands?"
