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In the Grade 3A class, we all celebrate our birthdays. Everyone comes with a birthday cake and sweets.




Today we celebrate

Next week we are celebrating my birthday. My name is Tsiko. I am a nine-year-old girl.




I stay with my grandmother and grandfather only. I am upset because they don't have enough money to buy a birthday cake and sweets to take to school.
