2nd International Conference on Transport and Health (ICTH 2016-USA)

This online-only supplement relates to the 2nd International Conference on Transport and Health – ICTH 2016-USA. The first article is about MINETA, the organisation hosting the 2016 conference in San Jose, California (Philbrick, 2016). This is followed by the abstracts from all the oral presentations (traditional and Pecha Kucha formats) and poster presentations at the conferences, in the order they appear in the programme. All abstracts were assessed anonymously by at least three reviewers, none being from any of the institutions represented by the list of co-authors.
